## THE SPEAKERS



#### DR. MICHAEL WENGER

Michael Wenger, born in 1972, caught the fever of discovery and travel from an early age. At the age of 17, he lived in Australia for a year, where he fell in love with the ocean and fish. During his biology studies on marine fish, however, the polar virus grabbed him on Svalbard.

Despite years of "resistance", including research and academic degrees, the virus did not let him go. So, he switched and instead of creating polar knowledge, he imparts it on trips, lectures, and in articles for Polar Journal AG. Since January 2023, he has also officially been CEO of the company and Editor-in-Chief.



#### **OLE ELLEKROG**

Ole Ellekrog is a journalist from Denmark. He holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from the Danish School of Media and Journalism and a joint Erasmus Mundus Master's degree in Journalism, Globalization and Media from Aarhus University, Denmark, and Charles University, Czech Republic.

His articles have appeared in several Danish and international magazines, including Wired, The New Arab, and The Guardian.

In 2023, he lived in Nuuk, Greenland, where he worked with science dissemination for Arctic Hub, contributing, among other things, to Paasisavut, Greenland's first PhD Cup.
